External Assessments

This month, our students began taking part in external assessments

These assessments provide valuable insight beyond classroom performance, allowing teachers to tailor lessons and support to meet each child's needs more effectively.

We have successfully completed the **CAT4** (**Cognitive Abilities Test**), which measures students' reasoning abilities in four key areas – verbal, nonverbal, quantitative, and spatial. This helps us understand how each child learns best and how we can nurture their potential in different subjects.



Currently, students are participating in the IBT (International Benchmark Test), which assesses core subjects such as English, Mathematics, and Science against international standards. The IBT results help us track academic progress and ensure that our teaching approaches are aligned with global expectations.




