ANNOUNCEMENTS

House Groups



We are excited to announce that the House System has officially been launched for the Academic Year 25-26! Every student and staff member has been assigned to a house, and students will now have the opportunity to earn points for their house through a variety of activities and achievements.

How it works:

- House charts and tally sheets are displayed in every classroom.
- House points are collected weekly and announced during Friday class assemblies.
- Students can earn points through demonstrating school values, achieving certificates, attending school regularly, showing ambition, and participating in inter-house competitions.

Some examples of rewards and competitions include:

- Values Points: For demonstrating school values anytime.
- Certificates: Each certificate contributes to house points.
- Special Rewards: Weekly snack time with the Principal (for 50 HPs), activity room access, or movies.
- Attendance Achievement: Classes with 100% attendance over a half term.
- Inter-House Competitions: Sports Day, Spelling Bee, PE Fitness Challenges, , BFPS Got Talent, Chess, Debating, and Maths competitions.

This is a wonderful opportunity for students to learn the value of teamwork, effort, and healthy competition while contributing to their house's success. We encourage all parents to support and celebrate their children's participation in this exciting new initiative!

Send healthy snacks and lunch – avoid fizzy drinks, chips, and chocolate.

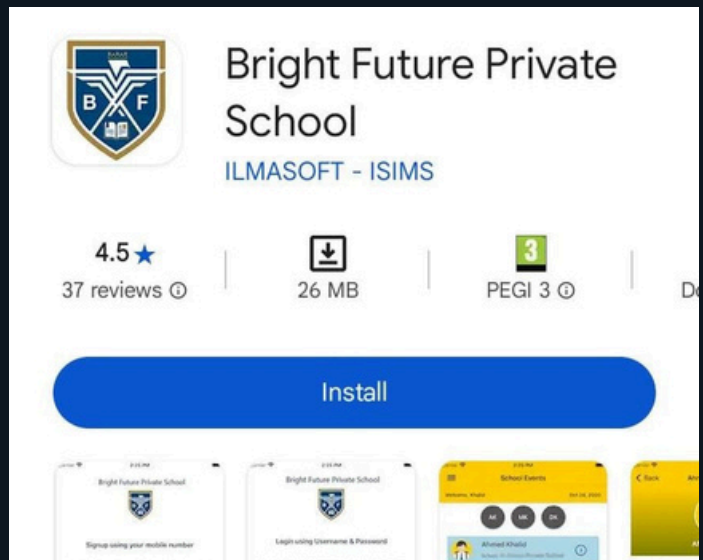
COMMUNICATION PLATFORMS

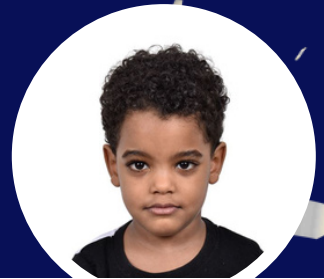

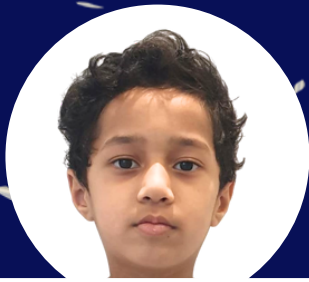

Very soon, we will be announcing the selected members who will help lead, share ideas, and make a difference in our school community.

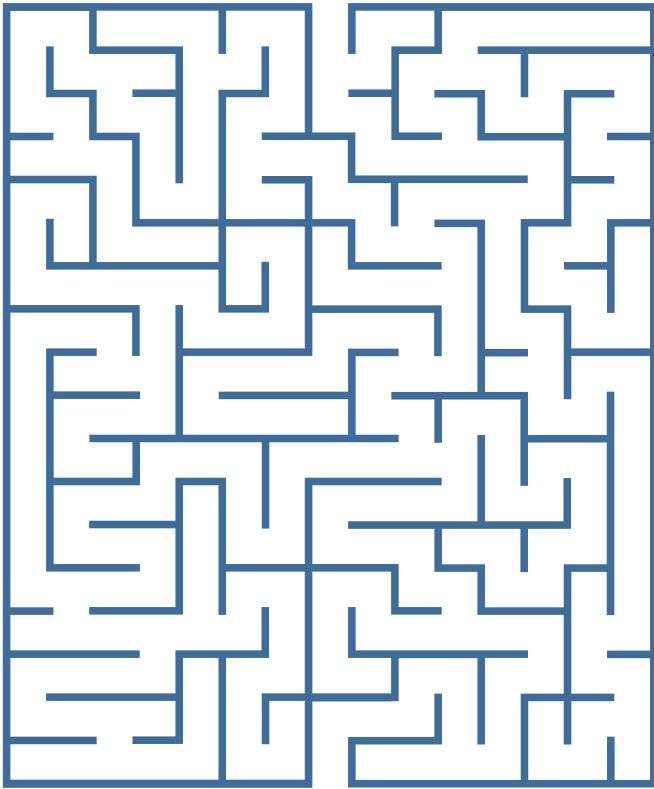

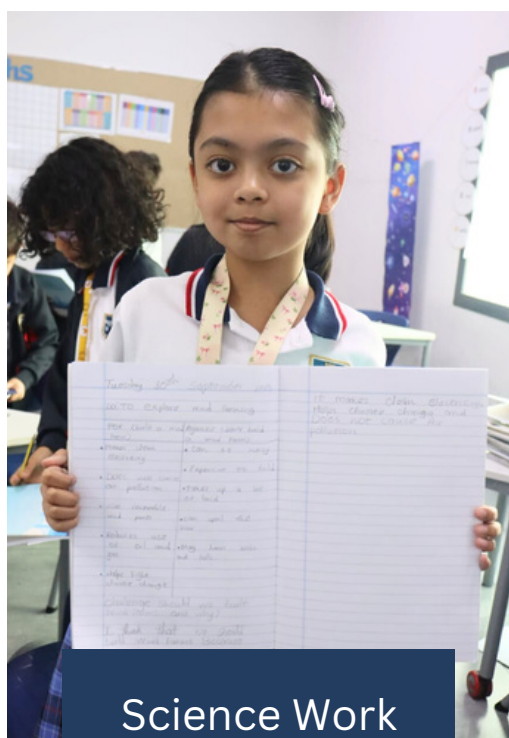
